

## Testing Information for 2025

Note: There are several changes from last year, so please read through the whole information flyer.

**Requirements:** Testing is required by the State of Oregon in grades 3, 5, 8, and 10. Testing must be completed no later than August 15. Individual school districts may require testing of home school students in other grades in order to participate in public school sports or activities.

**Testing:** Listed are two local options for in-person group home school testing for grades 3-12.

\*Remote testing information is listed at the bottom.

**Alison Herman** will be group testing on Thursday, **May 22<sup>nd</sup>** at a new location in **HERMISTON** at New Hope Church, 1350 S. Hwy. 395. **Janet Haddock** will be group testing Tuesday, **June 3<sup>rd</sup>** in **PENDLETON** at Pendleton Baptist Church, 3202 SW Nye Ave. Pendleton registrations and payments need to be to Janet by **May 12<sup>th</sup>**. **Testing cost** is \$70 per student for the test. The optional Performance Evaluation Report (PER) is an additional \$15 each. The PER gives you more specific information of the content of the questions and which kind of questions students missed or correctly answered. Grade 3 has a required \$8 consumable book fee.

**Sending registration:** Checks must accompany the registration and need to be received by the deadline.

Contact the tester if you run into issues with the deadline or the mail service. FYI Checks will not be cashed until after testing is completed.

**Practice tests:** are available through Basic Skills in hard copy or e-book and are reproducible for your own family.

**Testing day: Please get a good night's sleep and arrive by 8:45 a.m.** At 9:00 there will be a brief meeting of parents and students prior to starting testing. Students in grade 3 test separately. Grades 4-12 test together. Pencils and rulers are provided for all students. Calculators are optional for some tests but are not furnished. Students may bring a book to read while they are waiting for others to finish. They are encouraged to bring a snack for break time. **Phones, tablets, iPads, or other electronic devices should be left at home or with a parent or other adult during testing.**
